
NEW KEYHOLES TO HISTORY RELEASED

NEW ACQUISITION

Miniature Portrait of Capt. David Campbell, ca. 1781

Captain David Campbell (c.1760-1822) fought in the Revolutionary War with the 63rd Regiment of Foot. In 1781, Campbell returned to England where he had this portrait painted by George Engleheart who was later commissioned by King George III. He later immigrated to South Carolina to marry a woman he likely met while on campaign near Charleston. This watercolor on ivory depicts Campbell in his grenadier officer's dress uniform with a scarlet frock with deep green facings, lace and buttons in silver, and a silk silver epaulet. The miniature was made to be worn as a wrist bracelet and is curved in the center to fit on top of the wrist.
