

NEW ACQUISITION

1750-1760 English Grenadier's Basket-Hilted Hanger made by Samuel Harvey of Birmingham

During the American Revolution each battalion of the British Army contained a Grenadier company. Grenadiers were issued specialized equipment, such as this hanger, to not only denote their elite status but also to provide premium weaponry as they were often used as assault troops. These distinct and very wellmade swords afforded Grenadiers ample protection of their right hand as they did some of the heaviest hand-to-hand fighting of the conflict.
