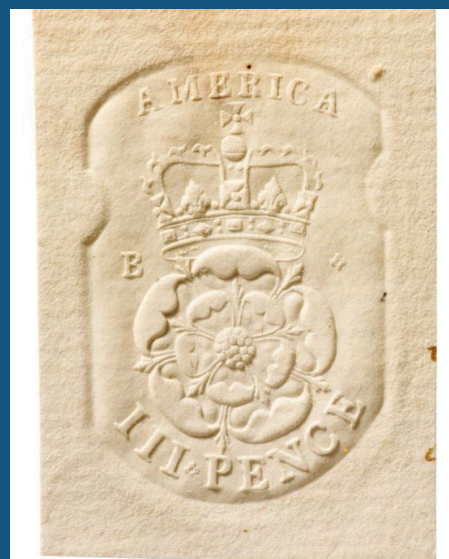


UPCOMING EVENT
