NEW ACQUISITION

Ca. 1750-1800 Knee-Held Tape Loom

Manual tape looms were such a common and ordinary implement found in colonial American homes that few examples of these tools survive today. This loom would be placed between the knees and used to produce "tapes" which were ribbon-like bands, straps, embroidered edges, etc. In the 18th century, these bands were used to secure or fasten myriad things including clothing, aprons, powder horns, loop hangers for tools, and to tie parcels shut.
